

Time Commitment

We have volunteer orientation training on the 3rd Wednesday of every month from 4:00-5:15. After you complete the training, you can sign up for your chosen activities or experience. Some volunteers come weekly or monthly, others may come as needed or for special events. Whatever you can give is valuable to our program.

We have two volunteer programs: Adult (age 18 and up) and Youth (under 18). Please note that youth under 15 must be accompanied by a parent when they are volunteering.



Our Mission

Page Robbins Adult Day Care Center is an independent non-profit agency that provides exceptional day care for people with memory loss from Alzheimer's disease, vascular dementia and other forms of memory loss. We also serve older adults who may have little to no memory loss but are frail and will benefit from socialization and caring oversight during the day. We are open from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday-Friday and serve families in Shelby County, Fayette County and some northern Mississippi Counties. We receive no funds from the government or other agencies to support our costs. To keep our participants' costs reasonable and care accessible, we charge families about 1/2 of the daily cost and rely on fundraising and donations to make us the difference.
